Accessing PowerScribe From The Side Computer To Edit And Sign Off Reports During Readout

PQI Project Team

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1. Log off PowerScribe on your main PACS station

You can only use PowerScribe on one computer at a time. Log off (File → Logoff) on your PACS station before readout. You don't have to exit the program, just logoff.

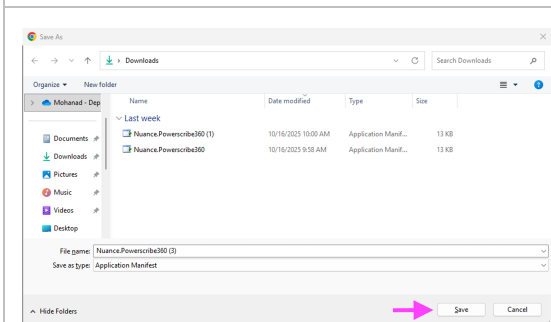
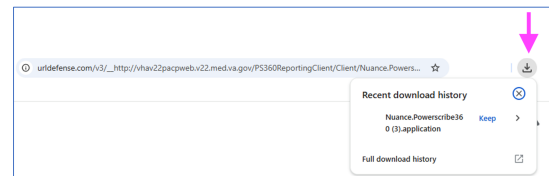
2. Access PowerScribe on the side computer

Copy and paste the following link into the browser:

3. Launch the downloaded file

Follow the on-screen prompts to start PowerScribe.



4. For convenience, copy and paste the link into a text file and save it on your desktop for quick access.
